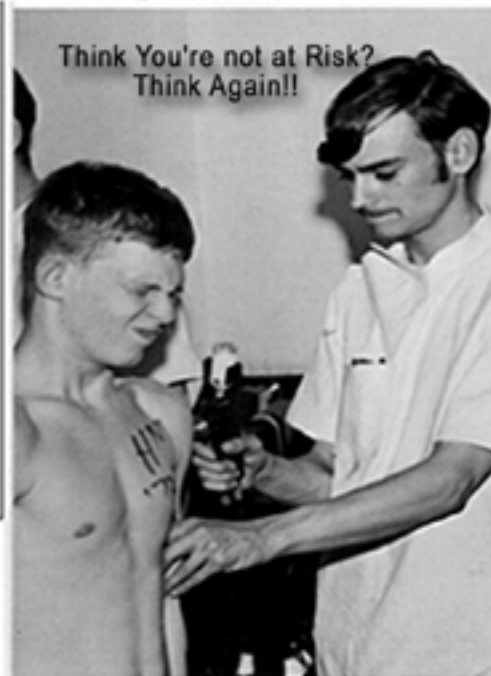

All photos were taken from "The Keel" which was issued to each recruit of Company 020 upon completion of recruit training on 26MAR1975. Not only was the entire Company 020 to receive immunization via the jet gun injector, but the sister Company 021 received the jet gun administered immunizations at the exact same immunization session. During this quite bloody process there was no wiping of the jet gun, nor was there any wiping of recruits.

Job-related infections hard to prove

The Kansas City Star: Lawrence Deyton, who directs VA public health programs, "it's possible the devices could transmit hepatitis C...., I am sure...with the **right degree of misuse, the devices (jetguns) could become contaminated.**"

Vaccines in the Military Department of Defense-Wide review of Vaccine Policies and Procedures "Of note.. the AFEB made a site visit to the MTF at Parris Island and directly observed high volume recruit immunization using jet injectors. **It was noted that jet injector nozzles were frequently contaminated with blood, yet sterilization practices were frequently inadequate or not followed.**"
